

Bursary Application Information

Criteria

The successful applicant must be a child under the age of 21 of a current member of an OSSTF Support Staff Bargaining Unit, pursuing post-secondary studies.

The applicant must be a dependent child or ward of a District 5A Support staff member, or deceased member, of OSSTF/FEESO in good standing.

The applicant must be entering a publicly-funded post-secondary college or university program or an apprenticeship program. All awards are made conditional upon the recipient being enrolled in the program and proof of tuition paid equal to or greater than \$800. It will be the responsibility of all successful recipients to ensure that documentation confirming enrolment and paid tuition is received by the District 5A Support Staff President. Applicants must provide a letter from the registrar once they have started their 2nd semester. Bursary monies must be claimed within 2 months once all paperwork has been received.

The applicant must submit either an essay or an opinion piece on one of the following topics.
