

Dryden Fibre Canada Scholarship Application

Dryden Fibre Canada is offering:

- three (3) \$1,000 TRADE scholarships to qualifying students at Dryden High School who
 are in their final year entering into either a TRADE APPRENTICESHIP EXPERIENCE
 and/or to study in the TRADES OR TRADE RELATED PROGRAMS at a recognized College
 or Technical Institute
- **four (4) \$1,000 scholarships** to qualifying students at Dryden High School who are in their final year entering into any field of **POST SECONDARY STUDY** at a recognized University, College or Technical Institute
- **one (1) \$1,000 scholarship** to a qualifying student at Dryden High School in their final year. Qualified applicants for this scholarship are those students who have successfully completed a **CO-OP PLACEMENT EXPERIENCE** at Dryden Fibre Canada *(formerly Domtar)* at any time during their time at DHS and are entering into either;
 - study in the TRADES OR TRADE RELATED PROGRAM at a recognized College or Technical Institute
 - TRADE APPRENTICESHIP EXPERIENCE
 - Or entering into any field of study at a recognized University, College or Technical Institute

In order to qualify, students must demonstrate and provide the following:

- Successful completion of grade twelve Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)
- A maintained academic average of 70% in your grade 11 and 12 years
- Demonstrated community involvement through volunteerism (including the number of hours accumulated)
- Participated in school involvement and extracurricular activities
- A short, written essay (500 words) describing why you have chosen this career path. Please describe your community involvement and extracurricular activities explaining how those experiences will support you in your career endeavours.
- A written letter of recommendation (family members excluded)

Note to applicants:

- Scholarships are deferrable for up to one year with written request to Dryden Fibre Canada from the selected student.
- Although students are welcome to apply for more than one scholarship, only one scholarship will be awarded per applicant
- In order to receive payment, students who are selected as scholarship recipients must provide to Dryden Fibre Canada an official **proof of enrollment** from their post-secondary institution.
- Trade applicants that are moving directly into an apprenticeship experience will need to provide a letter of confirmation from their employer / apprenticeship lead to verify their apprenticeship placement.
- All required material is to be emailed to dloewen@drydenfibre.ca before October 31, 2024. No funds will be released until proper confirmations are received.
